### Tax claimed by the St Edburg's Church Reordering Fund

- The St Edburg's Church Reordering Fund will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The St Edburg's Church Reordering Fund will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay St Edburg's Church Reordering Fund an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for St Edburg's Church Reordering Fund does not affect your personal tax position.

**If you pay income tax at the higher rate**, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
